Art is for Everyone at MMAM's Spring Seasonal Saturday

On Saturday, May 11, the Minnesota Marine Art Museum (MMAM) will hold its Spring Seasonal Saturday event focused on the theme Scenic Splendor, inspired by the exhibition Re/Framing The View: Nineteenth-century American Landscapes, on view now at MMAM through August 4, 2024. On loan from the New Bedford Whaling Museum (New Bedford, Massachusetts), Re/Framing The View, takes a layered approach to looking at landscape painting and artists from the 1800s.

Project FINE will be at the museum from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. to offer interpretation for Spanish and Hmong speaking participants.
